Collection Days/Dates

For every other week garbage customers, garbage is collected on the same week as recycling. Yard waste is collected on alternate weeks, except for December, January and February, when it is collected once a month only.

Holiday Schedule

Collections will be done on the regular scheduled day on all holidays in 2010 EXCEPT for Thanksgiving week: Thursday's collections will be done on Friday, and Friday's on Saturday.

Set Out

Please put all garbage, recycling, and yard waste carts out before 7 a.m. Remove your carts from the curb or alley within 24 hours of collection.

Alley residents: please place your recycle and yard waste carts on your side of the alley for collection. Carts must have 5 feet of clearance from other carts, mailboxes, cars, etc.

Lids must be closed, and only material
in the carts will be collected.

Not in Garbage Carts

The following are not allowed in your garbage cart: large bulky items (furniture, appliances, etc.), construction material, dirt, rock, sod, and liquid waste.

Residential household hazardous waste can be taken to the Moderate Risk Waste Facility at the Regional Transfer Station, open Wednesday and Saturday 11 a.m. - 4 p.m.

Yard waste is not allowed in garbage carts. Your alternatives are backyard composting, grass mulching, subscribing to yard waste collection, or taking your yard waste to the Port Angeles Transfer Station for composting. Some local businesses will also take yard waste.
